Abstract: Points out the futility of depending on title-entry for literature-search. Traces the present dependence on an unhelpful multiplicity of rules for the rendering of a name-of-person or for the choice and rendering of corporate author's name to an inheritance from the past. Recommends the conservation of cataloguing manpower by the international adoption of the Indian Standard for Author Statement on back of Title-Page. Recommends also the consideration of the best way of bringing to the notice of a reader all the books related to the book engaging his attention at the moment.
